Teacher Guidelines Non-Competitive Division

Purpose

The Non-Competitive Division was formed to allow students of any age and level of advancement to play for the enjoyment and experience without competing.

Repertoire

Students must play an original composition of any Baroque composer. Tasteful arrangements/transcriptions of Baroque music are allowed for **non-keyboard** instruments.

Rules

1. Copied music is not allowed and students will not be allowed to perform without an original score for the adjudicator. However CD sheet music is acceptable.
2. Time limit for each student is 5 minutes.
3. Students playing in this event are not competing, and therefore will not be chosen to play in the Regional or Final Event Recital.
4. Entry forms and fees must be **received**, by the District Junior Bach Festival Chairperson, no later than January 11th, 2010. Any forms received after that date will not be accepted.
5. All music is to be performed from memory.

Additional Information

The adjudicator may be a district teacher if he/she meets the qualifications.

Each participant will receive a certificate and adjudicator comments.
