Syllabus Level VI and Level X  
Honors Recital Entry Form

To be completed by teachers of eligible  
Level VI or Level X candidates

The Syllabus Level VI and Level X Honors Recital will be in-person and/or virtual in 2026. The in-person recital will be held **Saturday June 13, 2026, 3-6PM at the Calvary Lutheran Church, 937 NE Jackson School Rd, Hillsboro, OR 97124.**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Students must have completed the following to be able to play in the Level VI and Level X Recital:

- **Level VI students must have completed a Level VI exam** in addition to a minimum of 3 other Lower Division exams with any combination of Evaluation, Demonstration, or Audition/Creative Audition.
- **Level X students must have completed a Level X Exam** in addition to a minimum of 2 Lower Division and 2 Upper Division exams; or Levels VII, VIII, and IX Upper Division exams, with any combination of Evaluation, Demonstration, or Audition/Creative Audition.

Students may choose to play in one or both recitals. Memorization is required for both recitals. Repertoire must be chosen at the student's Syllabus level in accordance with the Syllabus Repertoire guidelines but does not have to be the same as any of the pieces performed during the student's Syllabus exam. Performance length is eight minutes maximum. **This form and video links are due May 31, 2026.** Please complete registration and send in entry form and/or video links before the deadline so that we can avoid last minute changes.

**\*Have your student make a recording of their piece.**

1. Students should dress nicely as for a public recital.
2. If filming with a phone or tablet, please film in "landscape mode," with the device set horizontally, not vertically. No handheld video. Use a tripod or brace the iPad or phone on solid surface to reduce camera motion.

3. Make sure there is good lighting on the student's face and the keyboard. Avoid backlighting.
4. The recording device should be positioned to capture the performance from the side, including the student's hands and profile of face.

**\*Have your student upload their recording to their YouTube channel.**

1. Please set privacy to Public, not Unlisted or Private, so the link can be included in OMTA YouTube channel playlists.
2. Select "Not for Children" so the chair can link the performances.
3. Have students send their video links to you first to verify that everything is correct. They should use their best recording.
4. The YouTube channel upload should include the following information in this order:  
**Title:** 2026 OMTA Syllabus Level VI and Level X Honors Recital  
**Description:** **1st line:** Performer: student's first and last name  
**2nd line:** Name of the piece and composer's first and last name  
**3rd line:** Teacher's first and last name
