Date: Saturday, October 9, 2021

Eligibility: Students of high school age and younger (age 19 maximum)

Registration Opening: Monday, August 9, 2021 on [Leggiero](#)

Registration Deadline: Friday, September 10, 2021

Video Submission Deadline: Wednesday, October 6, 2021 11:59PM PST

Registration Fee: OMTA Member Fee: \$30/student (Non-member Fee: \$35/student)

Location: Virtual online due to pandemic restrictions. See video submission instructions on <https://oregonmta.org/sonatina-festival/>.

Time: Video submissions will be evaluated day of event.

OVERVIEW: The OMTA Sonatina Festival is a biennial competitive event, taking place every other year. It gives students of high school age and younger the opportunity to compete with other students by performing before an adjudicator in a private audition. Each student receives a written evaluation of their performance. The festival encompasses ten levels, each of which is represented by one or more Sonatina/Sonata movements selected from various composers, periods, and styles. The [Required Repertoire List](#) correlates with OMTA Syllabus levels and is published in January the same year of the Sonatina Festival. All students within the same level perform the same piece.

GUIDELINES: Students may enter only one level and must perform from memory. There is no age restriction for students entering Levels 4-10. However, for students entering Levels 1, 2 or 3, the suggested age limit is 12 years old. Students should not take repeats unless noted otherwise on the repertoire list.

HONORS RECITAL AND AWARDS: Adjudicators will choose first and second place video submissions from each level that will be compiled into an honors recital video to be shared after festival date. Teachers will be notified by email with competition results no later than 8:00pm PST the following day, Sunday, October 10. As many as three additional students from each level may be chosen to receive Honorable Mention. All participants will receive a participation ribbon. All decisions by the adjudicators are final.

LEGGIERO INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Log into Leggiero account.
2. Select "Edit My Account" and confirm your address is current.
3. Choose "State" as the district.
4. Under "Festivals" select "Sonatina Festival".
5. Input the title, composer, and duration of piece.
6. Under "Special Circumstances," please list level with a zero in front of the number (e.g. "04"). Level 10 does not require a zero in front of the level number. Also, indicate if you are able to volunteer as a room monitor that day.
7. Print the receipt. Mail the receipt and a check made payable to OMTA to:
